Finished Quilt Approximately: 25" x 70" - Finished Block Size: 12" x 12"

Holiday Magic fabrics by Exclusively Quilters - Style #3901

Fabric Requirements: Based on 44" wide fabric

1/2 yard black cardinal print (#60523-8 black)

7/8 yard cream cardinal print (60523-9 cream)

3/8 yard red metallic (#60524-1 red)

3/8 yard green metallic (#60524-6 green)

1-1/8 yards black metallic (#60524-8 black)



1/2 yard black solid (#400-400-888)

2-1/8 yards fabric for backing (#60526-9 cream suggested)

30" x 76" quilt batting

template plastic

Cut squares
as indicated:



Make Template: Trace template onto template plastic. Cut out and label.

Cutting Directions: All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

From the **black cardinal print** fabric:

Cut one 12-1/2" x 42" strip, recut into two 12-1/2" squares

From the **cream cardinal print** fabric:

Cut one 12-7/8" x 42" strip, recut into one 12-7/8" square* and one 12-1/2" square

Cut four 2-1/2" x 42" strips

From the **red metallic** fabric:

Cut three 3" x 42" strips

From the **green metallic** fabric:

Cut three 3" x 42" strips

From the **black metallic** fabric:

Cut two 6-1/4" x 42" strips, recut into eight 6-1/4" squares**

Cut five 2-1/2" x 42" strips for binding

Cut six 1-1/2" x 42" strips

From the **black solid** fabric:

Cut one 4" x 42" strips, recut into eight 4" squares


Cut four 1-1/2" x 42" strips

An added 1/8 to 1/2 yard is added to all yardages to account for shrinkage, straightening, cutting errors and prints that may require special cutting to get the best results.

You should protect your investment in time and fabric by making sample blocks before cutting into your fabric because Exclusively Quilters will take no responsibility for replacing fabrics.

Shops who wish to kit this design are responsible for figuring yardage for their kits if they wish to reduce yardages.

Star Point Template


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Star Blocks:


1. From the 3" x 42" red metallic strips, cut a total of (32) Star Point Templates. Cut (32) Star Point Templates from 3" x 42" green metallic strips.




2. Piece each red star point with a green star point, half with the red on the right and half with the red on the left.




3. Piece star points into four of each half star unit.



4. Stitch a black metallic 6-1/4" quarter-square triangle to ends of each star unit.



5. Using a set-in seam (partial seam piecing) stitch a 4" black square between the two center points and the remaining black metallic 6-1/4" quarter-square triangles to fill in the sides. Set in seams are made by sewing the one side of the piece to the unit, then removing the seam from under the sewing machine needle, repositioning and sewing the other side of the piece to the unit.



Assembly:

1. Referring to Quilt Layout on Page 3, lay out the star blocks with the cream and black cardinal print squares and half-square triangles.

2. Sew the squares and triangles into diagonal rows. Sew the rows together.

3. Make two long black strips by sewing two 1-1/2" x 42" strips together end-to-end. Repeat to make two long strips with 2-1/2" cream cardinal print and 1-1/2" black metallic.

4. Make two border panels each with a long 1-1/2" black strip and 1-1/2" black metallic strip sewn to opposite sides of each 2-1/2" cream cardinal strip.

5. Sew the border panels to the long sides of the center. Press and trim excess.

6. Sew the remaining 1-1/2" metallic black strips to the short ends of tablerunner. Press and trim excess.

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Finishing:

1. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired.
2. Prepare binding from five 2-1/2" x 44" black metallic strips. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.
3. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.
4. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together right sides together. Trim seam to 1/4" and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
5. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.
